# **Mission**





The University of Adelaide, University of South Australia and Flinders University are three major universities making significant contributions to global R&D across various schools of science covering medicine, biology, chemistry, environment, technology, engineering and more.


Included in Adelaide's BioMed City are: the New Royal Adelaide Hospital (RAH), which, opened in 2017, is one of the largest and most advanced hospitals in the world; The University of Adelaide's Health and Medical Sciences Building supporting 1500 medicine, nursing and dentistry students and 400 health sciences researchers; the University of South Australia's Health Innovation Building (HIB) housing the Centre for Cancer Biology (CCB) and up to 250 of Australia's top cancer researchers; and the South Australian Health And Medical Research Institute (SAHMRI), incorporating state—of—the—art laboratories and equipment and housing over 600 researchers practicing world—leading medical and technology innovation across several key themes such as Cancer, Heart Health, Nutrition & Metabolism, Mind & Bran, Infection & Immunity, Aboriginal Health and Healthy Mothers, Babies & Children. SAHMRI 2 is due to open in 2020 and will house the only Proton Therapy Unit in the Southern Hemisphere, expanding Adelaide's capacity to conduct ground—breaking research, and dramatically increase Australian patients' access to the best care.

# **Convention Venue**

#### ADELAIDE CONVENTION CENTRE

In 2017 the Adelaide Convention Centre opened its brand new East Wing, part of a major two-stage transformation which has significantly increased capacity and flexibility of the venue and incorporates state of the art, versatile meeting facilities. Situated on the picturesque River Torrens the Centre is ideally located adjacently to over 3,000 hotel rooms, Adelaide's BioMedical Precinct and within close walking distance of sporting and entertainment venues.

Included in the facilities are a new Plenary Hall seating up to 3,500 delegates, 32 flexible, multi-purpose meeting rooms of all sizes, 20,000m² of pillar-less exhibition space, a 600 -seat Panorama Ballroom with spectacular views, two rotating 'seating pods' in the plenary hall create revolutionary break-out space for 300 delegates each and state of the art audio-visual and Wi-Fi technology allowing 12,000 individual connections. Extensive, light-filled foyer spaces with panoramic views are available for all types of functions, registration and exhibition space. The Centre is a Gold Certified Earth Check venue with environmental sustainability and social responsibility embedded as part of its culture.

#### Why 1 A hub of traveling

Daejeon, located in the very heart of South Korea, is located within 2~3 hours of any location in the country, including 50 minutes from Seoul, 90 minutes from Busan, and 30 minutes (KTX and BRT) from the Multifunctional Administrative City (Sejong). It is also a transportation hub of the country, passed through by the Gyeongbu, Honam and Daejeon Expressways and the Tongyeong-Dangjin Expressway.

Daejeon is Korea's largest city of science, hosting Korea's first special R&D zone, home to some 70 research institutes including universities and government-invested research institutes, more than 800 corporate research centers, and in excess of 1,300 tenant companies. The Expo Regeneration Project and the creation of the International Science Business Belt are expected to create explosive synergies with the city's proximity to the Multifunctional Administrative City.

## Mecca of Science and Technology

Daejeon is now a major city for cutting-edge science and technology in Korea. There are 232 research and education institutes including the Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST), the National Fusion Research Institute (NFRI), the Korea Aerospace Research Institute(KARI), and the Korea Atomic Energy Research Institute(KAERI).

Daedeok Innopolis has now become a centre of R&D and a leader of development in Korea's scientific technology. Functioning under UNESCO, one can also find the headquarters of the World Technopolis Association (WTA) in Daejeon, strengthening the City's renowned reputation for science and technology.




# **Convention Venue**

Daejeon Convention Center (DCC) is one of Daejeon's premiere conference centers with a unique, sophisticated architectural design, a beautiful view and modern facilities. DCC, which opened in 2008, consists of a Grandballroom, an Exhibition Hall, a Conference Hall, and 24 meeting rooms designed to accommodate all kinds of meetings and convention activities.

Though it is considered a comparatively latecomer to the MICE industry, Daejeon has rapidly positioned itself as one of the leading cities in this field after the opening of the Daejeon Convention Center. To date, the DCC has been the venue for 80 international meetings in various scales, including the 23rd IAEA Fusion Energy Conference 2010, the 60th International Astronautical Congress (IAC) 2009. With a growing list of successful conferences, DCC is becoming one of the most popular convention centers in Korea.

DIME Exhibition Center (KOTRA Exhibition Center in Daejeon), Expo Park, Daejeon Culture and Arts Center, the Municipal Museum of Fine Arts and Hanbat Arboretum are located nearby the DCC, which provide a platform for experience in the latest science and technology.

Hyderabad Convention Visitors Bureau (HCVB) is a marketing body along with the Department of Tourism, Government of Telangana whose functions includes showcasing Hyderabad as the Convention Capital of India, research and seek institutions and associations that are looking for a city to hold their meeting events. Our membership includes conference venues, Hyderabad's finest hotels, globally acclaimed Professional Conference Organizers, the Hyderabad airport, a transportation company, tourism packages and facilities – all the ingredients needed for a marketing bureau to offer a Whole of the City Approach. HCVB is the only bureau of its kind in India.

# **Convention Venue**

Hyderabad International Convention Centre (HICC) is managed by AccorHotels, is a purpose-built, state-of-the-art convention facility, the first of its kind in South Asia. It features an internal hall measuring 6,480 square meters that can be partitioned into six smaller halls.

Some of the world-class features that HICC offers are:

- State-of-the art IT infrastructure, design, technology, telecommunications and AV equipment
- Pillar less internal hall of net 6,480 sq. metres that can hold an 6,000-delegate plenary and can be portioned into 6 smaller halls
- · A spacious pre-function foyer area
- 37 breakout rooms, including specialized meeting rooms, speaker preparatory room, boardrooms, VIP lounge
- 12.5 metre high ceiling, roof cat walkers and truss to withhold heavy suspension

Norway Trade Fairs, Norway's largest convention center is ideally located between the airport and the city, and only a 10 min train ride from either. Another of Oslo's strength is how the main conference hotels, congress center and most famous landmarks are all located within walking distance of each other, allowing participants to experience the vibrant life of Oslo and explore the city's diverse neighborhoods.

## Visit OSLO / Congress Sales Department

# University of Oslo (UiO)

Attended by 32,000 students in 2017, the University of Oslo is a cluster of world class teaching and research facilities. The University administers a centrally located campus, four university hospitals and two museums. In addition to 10 research Centres of Excellence, the Norwegian Research Council has also created 6 Centres for Research Based Innovation, a project which strives to encourage and develop collaboration between Norwegian research groups and innovative partners from the private sector and public enterprises. UiO's strategic research areas are Life Sciences, Energy and the Nordic Countries, a choice which illustrates how UiO, and Oslo are turned towards the future.

#### Oslo Science Park

Located 8 minutes from the City Centre and located next to the campus of the University of Oslo, Oslo Science Park combines workspace, offices, labs, two business incubators (health and tech) as well as a conference centre. 250 companies and research organizations have already chosen Oslo Science Park and it is Norway's largest and most dynamic incubator with 70 start-ups.

# **Convention Venue**

## Norway Trade Fairs

Norway Convention & Exhibition Centre is Norway's largest meeting venue. It is a modern trade fair center located in Lillestrøm, a near suburb of Oslo. Norway Trade Fairs is located a 10 min train ride away from the airport or the city and trains depart every 10 min.

The largest meeting room setup, has a total capacity of 6,000 seats and can be divided with soundproof partition walls, into four halls of 1,500 seats.

Combined with the adjacent hotel, Thon Hotel Arena, the centre can offer up to 55 meeting rooms of different sizes, as well as an additional 33,000 sqm of exhibition space.

Most of the meeting rooms and exhibition halls are located on the ground floor, making the centre extremely flexible for conferences and exhibitions.



## Prague InSpires!

Prague, the city of hundred spires, is the capital of the Czech Republic and the largest city of the country. Currently, it's a home to more than 1.2 million inhabitants – nearly the same number as in Birmingham. Laying in the heart of Europe and connected with 145 destinations by direct flights, Prague is one of the easiest accessible places for people not only from all around the Europe.

Prague with its rich historical and cultural potential attracts over 6 million tourists a year. Among the most visited sights are Prague Castle (one of the biggest castles in the world), Charles Bridge, or the Old Town Square with famous Astronomical Clock. The first mentions of the city date back to the 8<sup>th</sup> century, and thus Prague teems with historical sites and monuments of different eras: Romanesque, Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, Art Nouveau, as well as Modern. Prague can boast with more than 2,000 protected heritage objects, and its historical city center was added to the list of UNESCO World Cultural and Natural Heritage in 1992.

You can enjoy the atmosphere of the city in every season from a boat on the Vltava River, relax in many parks, see the horizons from the nine Prague hills, discover the Prague underground, and last but not least, taste the famous Czech beer. Let the mother of cities, as Prague is also called, to surprise you – take a funicular ride, visit Prague vineyards, or climb the little sister of Eiffel Tower – Petřín Tower!

CIIRC's mission is to be an internationally recognized research institute contributing to student education and performing technology transfer. Two new ČVUT-CIIRC buildings were opened festively on May 2, 2017 in the ČVUT campus in Prague-Dejvice. CIIRC is developing its research projects gradually, increasing its research staff and strengthening its performance. CIIRC cooperates with faculties of ČVUT and other institutions. CIIRC contributes to the initiative Industry 4.0 of the Czech Republic Government. The first Industry 4.0 test bed in the Czech Republic is being built in CIIRC.

# Prague Congress Centre

The Prague Congress Centre is one of the largest and best-equipped congress centres in Europe with diverse spaces for the organisation of events of all kinds from large congresses, conferences, seminars, to smaller business meetings and presentations, and accompanying events such as exhibitions, medium-sized trade fairs, cultural performances and social events such as banquets and balls.

The Prague Congress Centre boasts an unrivalled location. The centre is located next to the main artery road through central providing easy access to the Czech Republic's motorway network and has guarded parking for 1,000 vehicles. With a metro station located directly next to the PCC, Prague's historic centre and main railway station are just 10 minutes away. The PCC boasts stunning views over Prague's Old Town and the Prague Castle.

#### Toulouse, a unique destination!

There is no doubt Toulouse is an exceptional destination for the great international conferences. Its competitive advantage in the aeronautic and aerospace industry resounds in all the continents, its efficient infrastructure and unforgettable identity, are transforming this European metropolis into a worldwide premier destination.

With its wealth of 2,000 years of history, Toulouse abounds of major historical sites and counts 80 museums labeled "Musées de France". But Toulouse is also an icon for progress and the future. This coexistence of strong tradition and permanent innovation makes Toulouse a favorable place to successfully overcome any challenge.

With more than 800,000 inhabitants, Toulouse is in a great demographic expansion phase and ranks first among the southern European cities, with a yearly increase of 10,000 inhabitants for the past 10 years.

Toulouse attracts so many because of its dynamism and unceasing projects: for example, the construction of a new convention center: 100,000 m² (1,076,391 sqft) of total surface with a great hall of 15,000 m², 40,000 m² of exhibition space, an outdoor exhibition space and numerous welcome and catering spaces.

#### So Toulouse

So Toulouse is the new trademark dedicated to outreaching tourism in Toulouse. Its goal is to assist in the planning of events and visits to our city, to uphold its image throughout the world, to entice visitors and businesses to come to discover Toulouse.

Located in the Southeast of France, innovative, sportive and festive, Toulouse cultivates its creativity and dynamism. Its festivals, its heritage, its Garonne River, its climate, its conviviality and cuisine make the pink city an attractive destination.







Toulouse is the centre of the European aerospace industry, with the headquarters of Airbus, Galileo positioning system, the SPOT satellite system, EADS, ATR and the Aerospace Valley, considered as a global cluster.

#### Aerospace valley

Aerospace Valley is a French cluster of aerospace engineering companies and research centres. The cluster is located in the regions of Midi-Pyrénées and Aquitaine in the southwest of France and is mainly concentrated in and around the city of Toulouse.

The over 500 affiliated companies (including Airbus, EADS, Air France Industries and Dassault Aviation) are responsible for some 120,000 jobs in the aviation and space flight industries. In addition, some 8,500 researchers are active within the affiliated companies and institutions.

The cluster's stated aim is to create 40,000 new jobs within the next 20 years. Since its inception in 2005, the cluster has initiated some 220 research projects with a total budget of 460 million euros, including 204 million euros in government funding.

# The Centre des Congrès Pierre Baudis

The flexibility of spaces allows for the welcoming of, in excellent conditions, congresses, conventions, symposiums, seminars, study days, gala dinners, product launches, festive events, trade shows, reviews and competitions. It can hold from 50 to 1,200 people.


